How to Get Help

- Eviction settlement help may be available for residential tenants ("defendants") who:
 - 1) Have an eviction case settlement conference
 - 2) Are unrepresented in their eviction case, and
 - 3) Are low-income (**below 80% area median income or received a court fee waiver**).
- Sign-ups start by 9 am on the day of the settlement conference, next to Dept. 511.
- Assistance is not guaranteed and may be firstcome, first-served, at the discretion of providers Eviction Defense Center, Centro Legal de la Raza, or East Bay Community Law Center.

Transit & Parking

- Public transit: The nearest BART station is Hayward BART. <u>AC transit</u> bus lines 60 & 86 connect BART to the courthouse.
- Parking garage: Follow signs to the Alameda County "Multi-Service Center Building" lot across from the courthouse.
- \$4 fee for all-day parking applies.



What to Bring

- **Case paperwork**: Summons & Complaint, Answer, and notice of trial date
- Evidence: Photos, rent payment receipts, etc.
- Income verification: Paystub, proof of public benefit (food stamps, SSI, Medi-Cal card, etc.)
- Bring snacks & anything you need for the day (such as medicine).
- Arrange for **childcare** as needed.
